1. Aim

5. Selection Criteria

The selection for admission / enrollment to this programme is based on the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and experience.

6. Admission

The admission for this programme will be done by “**The Director (Admissions)**”, **Anna University Tiruchirappalli, Tiruchirappalli**. A candidate seeking admission to this programme shall be allotted to the nearest centre. The candidate has to register for all the courses prescribed for the particular module and must forward the application / registration form to the Coordinator through the Head of the Organization.

7. Duration and Structure of the Programme

The minimum and maximum period for completion of this P.G. Degree Programme is 6 semesters and 14 semesters respectively.

The Professional Development Programmes will be conducted throughout the semester with a minimum duration of 3 working days per programme based on the number of credits in the respective module. The morning and afternoon sessions shall have 3 1/2 hours each.

Apart from PDP the remaining classes will be held on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays and assessments will be made on Sundays.
