

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR GETTING NSS AWARD

For Volunteers:

1. Should be NSS Volunteer
2. Should have served in NSS for 240 hours in two years
3. Should be between the age of 15-25
4. Should have completed 15 years on the 1st April
5. Should be less than 25 years on the 31st March
6. Should not have been conferred state award already
7. Should have attended at least one Special Camping Programme.

CONSIDERATION FOR AWARD

1. The activities undertaken in the rural areas, urban for the welfare of the people will be considered.
2. The services during the year and / will be considered for the award.
3. Preference should be given to the following:
 - Participation in National Level Camps
 - Participation in Inter – State Camps
 - Participation in State Level Inter-University Camps
 - Participation in MPFL, Blood Donation, Youth Club information participation, Work, Help to the physically handicapped, Cultural Programmes, mass cleaning etc.
 - Special work spontaneously done by the individual during famine, flood, cyclone, fire, drought, etc.
 - Assistance rendered in getting old age, widow pension, bank loans and other public welfare programme.
 - Participation in adventure programmes including life saving

FOR PROGRAMME OFFICERS / PROGRAMME COORDINATOR

1. The Programme Coordinator / Programme Officer should have served in NSS for minimum of TWO YEARS.
2. He / She should have undergone the General Orientation Courses.
3. Should have conducted a minimum of two special camps.
4. Should not have been conferred the State Award earlier .
5. In respect of Programme Officers preference would be given to the following:

Academic Contributions - 25% of Credit

Publication of journal papers presented / published, contribution of articles; participation in the training programmes; organisation / participation in the seminar workshop, etc.

Field Work contribution 50% Credit

Enrolment of student volunteers / organisation of regular programmes
organisation of Special Camping Programmes. Implementation of Special Programmes. State Level or Organisation of National Level Programmes.

Correspondence work 25% audit

Regular and periodicals Submission of reports and returns / finalisation of accounts.
